## **Missionary: Bob McKay**

There are a lot of needs in the country of Georgia with all of the new ministries that have recently begun! Mid summer they had the first evangelical crusade in the country of Georgia with evangelist David Hathaway from England. They believed this event would mark a turning point in religious freedom for the country of Georgia! God showed up in AMAZING ways! †

### **Testimony/Prayer Requests/Praises:**

The David Hathaway crusade was the greatest historical event in the history of the evangelical church here in Georgia. Some 1,800 people came to the Lord and hundreds were healed or touched in a great way, but the greatest effect was that it gave bible believing Christians legitimacy in a country where all of the population view us as a dangerous cult. Comments we hear are, "They really are Christians," "They love the Bible," and "This is what we need in our churches."

Since the crusade, not many churches have been planted because Georgia is much like the Muslim world. Things just don't happen that way without the relationships developing first. One thing has happened though. The vision of the churches to reach out to the unreached has changed. The motivation of the individual believer to "lifestyle evangelism" is much greater.

Right now we are in the beginning stages of kicking off the first ever Georgian Study Bible. We have permission from Thomas Nelson Publishers and the International Bible Society to revise all of the mistakes in the Georgia Bible (there are many) and to translate the notes from the Jack Hayford study bible. It will take 3-4 years to complete at least. ~Bob McKay Let us continue to lift up Bob McKay in prayer as he continues steadfastly in the work of the Lord!
