## ABOUT CFC'S MISSIONS DIRECTORS

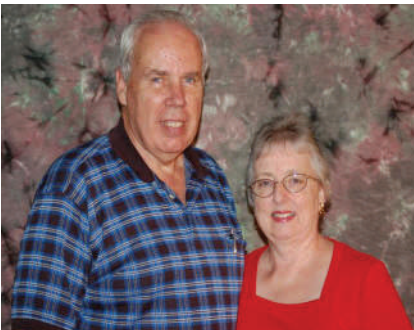


**Peter and Linda Weiss,
