Family Circus Ministry!

Family Circus Children's Ministry was created by Assembly of God missionaries Darrell and Sandy Blatchley in 1993 to produce high impact and joyful methods of presenting the Gospel to children and their families.

The purpose of the Family Circus is to bring the life and joy of Jesus, combining both discipleship and evangelism, to reach lost children, while ministering to the needs of the child, both spiritual and physical.

Each week five to six thousand people of all ages attend the Family Circus church services held under the 'Big Top', a big circus tent pitched in the center of the densely populated "Muslim Friendship Village" in Davao City, Mindanao City, **PHILIPPINES**. Approximately 4,000 of the 6,000-member congregation are children, half of whom are malnourished. More than 1,000 are adults.

Please pray for Darrell, Sandy, and the team that God would grant them sufficient: strength, energy, wisdom, knowledge, discernment, peace, and joy - unspeakable and full of glory!!

Pray for food - spiritual and physical - sufficient to help with the needs of those attending Family Circus.

Pray for supplies, building materials, permits, etc. for current and future needs of Family Circus.

Pray for health and safety for all those involved in the Family Circus mission outreach.

Before going to the mission field, **Tony and Trish Salisbury** ministered in two churches in Washington State. After serving in Japan as independent missionaries for seven years, **they joined the Assemblies of God World Missions in 1997.**

Since then, they have been involved in **church planting** and various other ministries in Japan. Tony and Trish are continuing their **pioneer work** in Joetsu City and helping the Niigata **Chi Alpha** ministry; however, their main focus is to relocate and **establish the church** in Shibata City. The Salisburys love to host short term **mission teams!**

Prayer requests:

1. After being in the States, Tony is buried under a mountain of paperwork.
2. The Salisburys have at least 40 new contacts from their evangelism outreach to follow up with. Pray that seeds which have been planted continue to grow!
3. God's blessing on two teams that came in May: the Turner Sisters (and mom) from Spokane and a team from Kansas City (IHOP).
4. Jon, their youngest son is behind in his homework because of sickness (he is better now).
5. Mrs. Hidano has not been coming to church for more than a month and needs

encouragement. She is depressed as a result of job loss and her sister's leukemia.

6. Pastor Tsuchiya (the only other A/G pastor in our prefecture) needs healing from tooth pain.

7. Pray that because the Salisbury's mission is to plant churches, the Lord would continue to provide as they equip leaders, establish new churches, and educate the Church.

The teams helped pass out tons of tracts door to door and held a **special sport day** at the city gym. They went campus **prayer walking** at Niigata and Keiwa Universities. They helped clean up around the mission's house and **plant flowers** and vegetables. (In Japan the pleasing appearance of homes and churches are a testimony to the community.)
